## NOUN

✚ Noun – A noun is a name of person, place, animal or thing.

Example – cat, dog, India, Suresh, table

✚ There are four types of Nouns.

(1) Proper noun – It is a specific name or proper name of person, place, animal or thing.

It begins with capital letter.

Example – Delhi, Sun, Raj

(2) Common noun – It is a common name of person, place, animal or thing.

Example – cat, table, chair, girl, city

(3) Collective noun – A collective noun is a word used to name a group of people, animals or things.

Example – a herd of cows, a flock of birds

(4) Abstract noun- A abstract noun is a noun which we cannot see or touch but feel it.

Abstract nouns are the words that name ideas, feelings, experiences and qualities.

Example – courage, honesty and wisdom
